## What would a remote season look like?

## What will a Remote Qualifier Tournament look like?

#### Full Remote Event Experience

- Event platform mirrors traditional experience
- Opening and Closing ceremony
- Youth and digital privacy protection
- EVERYONE must complete an online consent and release form prior to receiving access
- Activities will take place through pre-scheduled online meetings

# Judging changes this year

- Consolidated- single, 30 min session
- New Rubric Criteria
- Team ranking
- Number based evaluation
- Verbal feedback to teams







## Remote Robot Game

#### Two Options:

A- Teams will be required to **upload a single, unedited video** of each robot game round. Teams will provide video with three, 2.5 minute pre recorded robot rounds, time stamped within a single day. Team must secure a non biased monitor (e.g., school principal, FIRST Robotics Competition team members, other volunteer) to mark start and stop time for recording.
